Baptism: This important sign of initiation is celebrated in the community at any one of the weekend Masses. Parents must complete the preparation program (offered every other month). Please contact the church office at least two months prior to your anticipated date for Baptism.

Marriage: This sacrament provides an opportunity for a couple to stand as a sign of God's love in the community. To this end, a period of preparation is important and necessary. Contact the church office at least six months prior to your proposed marriage date to begin this process.

Anointing of the Sick: If you are preparing for surgery or hospitalization, this sacrament can be celebrated with you on any weekend at the church. In an emergency, contact the church so we can pray with you at home or in the hospital.

Alleluia! Christ is risen! He is risen indeed.

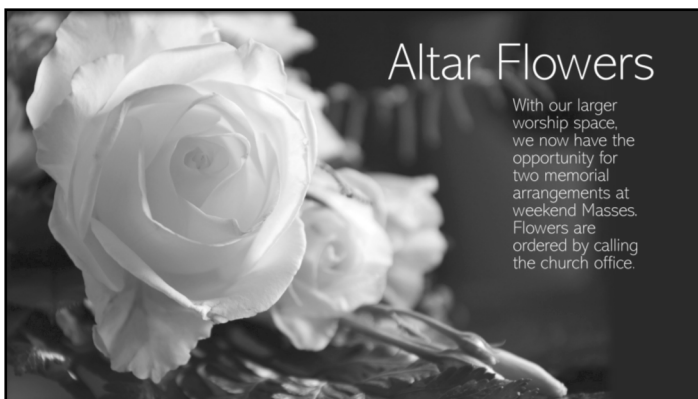

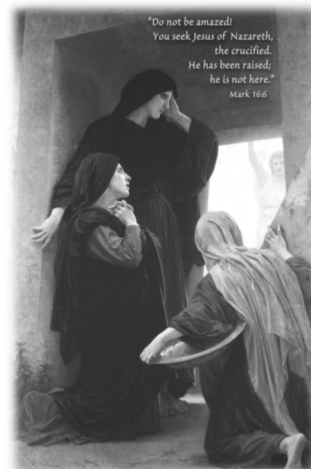

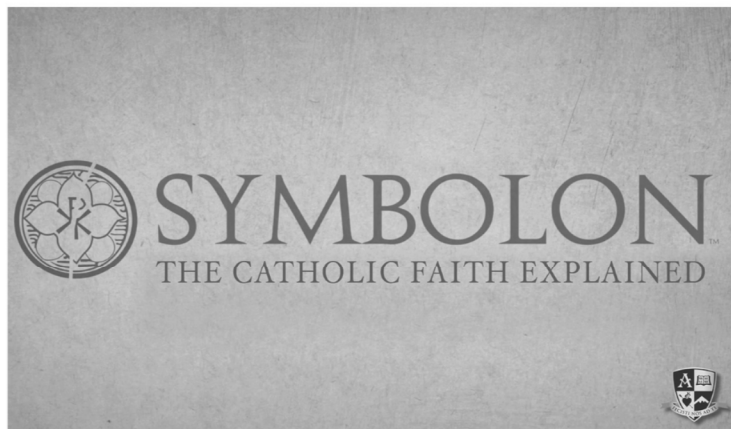

FORMED NOW: EVANGELIZING MILLENNIALS

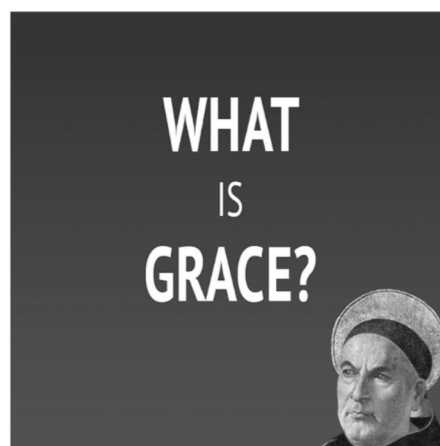

Reflexion

FELICES PASCUAS DE RESURRECCIÓN

Lo que hoy celebra la Iglesia no es sólo la resurrección de Jesucristo, su victoria sobre la muerte. Lo que hoy celebra la Iglesia es la resurrección de Jesucristo y también la resurrección nuestra. En Cristo, primogénito de ente los muertos, como le llama San Pablo, todos hemos resucitado. La victoria de Jesucristo sobre la muerte y sobre el pecado es también nuestra victoria. Esta es la gran verdad que hoy celebramos: que, si nuestra vida está unida a la de Cristo, estamos pasando ya de la muerte a la vida, estamos entrando ya en una vida nueva que no conoce la muerte. Lo que sucedió ya sacramentalmente, en el Bautismo, nuestra incorporación a Cristo, tiene que irse realizando día a día, en la fe, en la esperanza y en el amor, iluminado y transfigurando, con la fuerza del Espíritu, nuestros pensamientos, nuestras palabras y nuestras acciones, en la vida diaria, en todo lo que sentimos y hacemos, aun en las cosas más pequeñas. Hoy tenemos que vivir la inmensa alegría de experimentar en nuestro propio ser el misterio de la muerte y resurrección de Cristo: la alegría de morir, con Cristo, a lo viejo, lo caduco, lo que San Pablo llama las obras de la carne: la envidia, la soberbia, la pereza, la desilusión, la desesperanza. Hay que morir a todo eso. Hay que sepultar todo eso. Para renacer con Cristo resucitado a la vida del Espíritu: que es amor y es gozo y paz y benignidad y paciencia. En Cristo resucitado todos empezamos a participar ya de la vida eterna. Lo que ha sucedido en Cristo, sucederá también en todos que nos hemos incorporado a Cristo.

Celebremos con gozo este día hermoso de nuestra fe y que cada uno lo celebre con su familia haciendo un acto de fe, uniendo compromisos de nunca perder el fulgor de esta fiesta de la vida.

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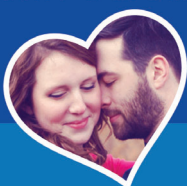
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
